### Server 2016

- Still supported by VISION.
- Minimum OS required for new VISION database features.
- Mainstream
   Support concluded
   on January 1,
   2022. Extended
   Support until
   January 12, 2027.

### Server 2012/2012r2

- Still supported by VISION.
- Mainstream Support ended October 9, 2018. Extended Support ends October 10, 2023.

### Server 2008/2008r2

 Mainstream Support ended January 13, 2015. Extended Support ended January 14, 2020.

## Server 2008



#### Not supported by Microsoft


- Security issues will not be fixed.
- Not optimized for current server hardware.
- If you break it, you're on your own.



#### DVI has ceased programming for 2008.

Windows Server2008 END OF LIFE

- Current programming tools unable to program for Server 2008.
- VISION releases cannot be performed.
- VISION updates, new features, and patches will not be installed.



SMB 1 & 2 (cont'd)

It's highly advised to disable SMB 1 because of known risks.

- Disabling SMB 1 without first transitioning to Server 2019 or the new VISION database system will result in data corruption or closedown failures.
- Only labs with Server 2016 or newer can upgrade to the new database system.



Windows 11

Newest desktop OS released (October 5, 2021)

Similarities under the hood make Window 11 not a huge improvement over Windows 10.

Microsoft's best imitation of the Linux look and feel.

New desktop experience.

Different Start Menu.

Colors, icons, and shapes are more modern.

Ability to switch between multiple "desktops".

Widgets are back.

Phased rollout by Microsoft, though a manual download is available.
